News

It is our ambition to update and send this newsletter to all members at least once a week as things progress with the sheds so that you can feel part of the process even though you cannot attend at present. It will show the progression of work on the sheds and anything else of interest. If you wish to contribute an article then please do so.

Lots of progress again since last time and its been more than a week (Sorry). The roof has been completed as far as possible until the slates arrive (Should have been Friday 31st July). All the 2" x 1" roofing slats are in place ready. The overhanging part of the roof is now supported by two posts. These were installed after digging two holes so they could be set in concrete.

The ends of the shed have been completed to the new higher level of the roof due to roof pitch increase from 10 degrees to 25 degrees. This gives the shed a much larger feel inside - A bit like the Tardis on Doctor Who!

Inside the first wall has been completed with the addition of insulation, a second vapour barrier and finished with the old outside cladding reversed on the inside. Finally, installed some shelves (You can never have too many of those). Very pleased with the final result with the added bonus of recycling old materials.
