News

I know it's another late newsletter but if there is little progress then there is not much to report. It is our ambition to update and send this newsletter to all members at least once a week as things progress with the sheds so that you can feel part of the process even if you find it difficult to attend at present although everyone is still welcome with a face mask and social distancing. We have produced a Covid 19 risk assessment.

Not a great deal of progress which is why I have delayed this newsletter. The interior walls are now finished with the exception of the window which is covered at present. All the doors are finished and insulated. The exterior and interior roof are both complete too. We are working outside on good weather days and inside on bad weather days which is probably why the inside is nearly complete and almost ready to use.

The LED remote control strip lighting is now complete and allows for warm white, cool white and daylight options as well as dimming for computer screen use. A test LED floodlight has been fitted outside and works really well and there will be two on each shed once the log cladding arrives. It's important to say the sheds can be used without the log cladding. Maybe fitting the log cladding can be a shed project as suggested by Alastair?
